Death and resurrection out of love

Summary. This little bell presents some reflections about the death and resurrection of Jesus and stresses His love and his calls for our conversion. The joyful song "Reinado de nueves" (Oh kingdom of nines) summarizes essential aspects of the entry and can be heard in Spanish here. The song can also be heard and visualized in Spanish in a YouTube video by the end of the text.

The blog <u>Presentation</u> provides information about the purpose of these little bells and the blog <u>Organization</u> shows how the entries are grouped by categories. This entry belongs to the categories "Jesus and the resurrection" and "Numerical little bells."

Jesus has risen and lives! Alleluia! Oh extraordinary event, worthy of all praise! Jesus has died out of love and has returned out of love!

Death, despite all its **diabolical** efforts, could not hold **Him**. It is **true**, and so it has been (Acts 2:14–36). **Jesus** is **who He claimed to be** and **fulfilled** what was entrusted to **Him** (Mt 17:22–23).

According to the **Synoptic Gospels** — **Matthew**, **Mark**, and **Luke** — when **Jesus** was crucified, *darkness* covered the whole land from *noon* until *three in the afternoon*, the hour at which **He** *died* (Mt 27:45, Mk 15:33, Lk 23:44). However, in those times, hours were not measured as they are now, but rather from sunrise. Thus, the account according to **Mark** would read:

"At the *sixth* hour *darkness* came over the whole land until the *ninth* hour. And at the *ninth* hour **Jesus** cried out in a loud voice, '*Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?*' which is translated, '*My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?*' Some of the bystanders who heard it said, 'Look, he is calling *Elijah*.' One of them ran, soaked a sponge with wine, put it on a reed, and gave it to him to drink, saying, 'Wait, let us see if *Elijah* comes to take him down.' **Jesus** gave a loud cry and *breathed his last*" (Mk 15:33–37).

As it was explained in a previous <u>little bell</u>, the numbers 6 and 9 correspond, both geometrically and mathematically, to *spirals* that differ only in the direction of their movement. On one side, there is the *negative spiral*, the 6, written in polar coordinates as:

$$r = e^{-\theta}$$

which rotates *inward*, and on the other side, there is the *positive spiral*, the **9**, given by:

$$r = e^{+\theta}$$

that flows *outward*. Here, r represents the *distance* measured from the *origin*, θ is an *angle* calculated *from the x-axis* (counterclockwise, by convention), and e is the *exponential number* ($\approx 2.7172...$), which was also *previously* associated with the **Holy Spirit**.

While the *negative spiral* occurs in nature — for example, in the <u>cascade of eddies</u> caused by *turbulence* and visibly in a destructive *hurricane* generated by a flow moving from *higher* to *lower pressures*, that is, from + to – (from *more* to *less*) — the *positive spiral* does not occur naturally, for, by "*traveling*" mathematically from – to + (from *less* to *more*), it goes against the laws of *physics*.

While the *spiral* of **6**, by its movement *toward its center*, clearly denotes our *selfish* attitudes and actions, the *spiral* of **9**, by *getting out from itself*, symbolizes the conscious choice of true *love*, always *dedicated to others*.

While the *negative spiral* is *vengeful* and maintains a fixation with the *past* — by its *counterclockwise* movement — the *positive* one does not hold onto offenses but *forgives*, traveling securely toward the *future*, in *alignment* with the hands of the clock.

In this context of shapes and movements, it is no coincidence that the *darkness* cited during the **Lord's crucifixion** occurred precisely from the *sixth* hour to the *ninth* hour and that **He died** on the *positive cross* precisely at the hour **9** of **love**. For the *cross* is *positive*, of course, and the word "*death*," despite its pain, ultimately shares the same color as **love**, for it all happened for us.

The *symbols* are powerful, for during such an interval, from 6 to 9 — and at any other time — we are accompanied by the *penumbra* of *sinfulness*, and such movement, guided by the

6, is only reversed into a **9** when we embrace the *cross* of *truth*, the **+**, to fully follow the *bright morning star* (Mk 8:34) — plenitude indeed! — for **Jesus** is *light* itself (Jn 8:12).

Based on the same geometries as in the **Gospel of Mark**, it also appears not to be by chance that the number assigned to the name of the man who will be the *antichrist* is precisely **666** (Rev 13:18) and that the evil one himself, the *devil*, by being a *murderer* from the beginning and by being a *liar* containing no truth in *him* at all (Jn 8:44), can be represented by an incomplete fraction that reflects his intrinsic *evil* and his final *defeat*:


$$2/3 = 0.666...$$

For it happens that the practice of **love** that **Jesus** always exercised (2 Cor 5:21), that is, a **9** repeated over and over again and always *positive*, *freely* given to us and for us, until **His** *death* on the *cross* — oh, congruent geometry in the ineffable sacrifice! — allows **Him** to satisfy a much better infinite equation:

$$1 = 0.999...$$

For this expression, perhaps strange if not previously meditated, beautifully relates the daily practice of **love** with *unity* and correctly expresses that only **Jesus** — by geometrically satisfying **His** crucifixion in $\underline{Y} = \underline{X}$ (*His silhouette* on the *cross*) and bearing a *crown of thorns* caused by our *sin* — can restore it all with **His** *real* and *infinite* **love**.

This beautiful formula, which invites us all to *unity* by freely embracing **love**, can be easily demonstrated. If x = 0.999..., then 10x = 9.999..., and thus, subtracting the first equation from the second results in 9x = 9, which implies x = 1, and therefore 0.999... = 1. All of this works because of the ellipsis, that is, because of *infinity!* And this is the same *infinity* that **Jesus** gifts us — *eternal life* — if we believe that **He** is who **He** is (Jn 3:36) ...



As recounted in the **Gospel according to Saint Luke**, **Jesus** *rose from the dead*, and after this extraordinary event, **He** explained to **His** disciples:

"These are my **words** that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the **law of Moses** and in the **prophets** and **psalms** must be **fulfilled**.' Then he opened their minds to understand the **scriptures**. And **He** said to them, "Thus it is written that the **Messiah** would suffer and **rise from the dead** on the third day and that **repentance**, for the **forgiveness of sins**, would be preached in **His name** to all the nations, beginning from **Jerusalem**. You are witnesses of these things' "(Lk 24:44—48).

Jesus returns from *death* — now in red — from *hell* itself, to make it clear that **He** has defeated *evil* and thus to complete, with all **His love** for us, **His** work of *redemption*. **He** also returns to send His *disciples*, also out of **love**, to all nations so that they may teach people to observe everything **He** has commanded (Mt 28:19—20), that is, the *primacy* of **His love** and **His love** alone (Jn 15:1—10).

The *loving* and *crucified* invitation to which *Jesus* calls us is none other than to **His** own *holiness* and that of **God the Father** (Mt 5:48):

$$\int_{0.999...}$$
 = 0.999... = 1

For the *holy power of zero* — a *circular "spiral*" with equation r = 1 in polar coordinates — is vividly and coherently reflected to the exemplary *conversion* of **Peter** himself — chosen by **Jesus** as the **rock of the Church** (Mt 16:18) — who after the resurrection of the **Just One**, responded affirmatively *three* times to the essential question of the **Savior**: "**Do you love me?**" (Jn 21:15—17), a question that was pronounced not only for the *disciple* but also for each one of <u>us</u>. For it is very well known that **Peter**, now a **saint** with due **halo**, *denied* **Our Lord** *three* times before the rooster crowed *twice* (Mk 14:66—72), hence defining a clear *two-thirds*, and we have made such a denial many times, and as of me I <u>confess</u> that I have often allowed myself to be seduced by the **6**, abundantly.

How beautiful it is to observe in the vital *conversion* from 2/3 = 0.666... — with truthful arithmetic in the bird's song — to 3/3 = 1 = 0.999... (by giving the definitive "*yes*" to love), the required transition from the *incomplete*, *false*, and *broken* to the *loving*, *true*, and *complete!* How wonderful it is to recognize that the *symbols* are *universal* and that Jesus

calls us to go away from *darkness*, of that which produces *death*, the *negative 6*, towards the *true* and *free* reign of *love*, towards *His kingdom of nines!* How relevant it is to understand that we must be *ready* to respond to *evil* doing *good* (Rom 12:21) and that this only happens by traveling *straight* along *the hypotenuse*, that is, by the *square root of two* — which is also *lesus!*

How can we not understand that we can experience, on a daily basis, **His** *resurrection* through the same *conversion* towards *light* that transformed **Saint Peter** — that is, from the *death* caused by *sin* to *life* — knowing, in addition, that **Jesus** promises to be with us every day until *the end of the world* (Mt 28:20)? How can we not joyfully repeat endless *alleluias* while proclaiming the *Good News* to all creation, as **He** commands us to do (Mk 16:15)? How can we not desire that the *baptism* of **Jesus** be imparted for the *conversion* and *salvation* of all (Mk 16:16)?

To conclude and summarize, here is translation of a Spanish song titled "*Reinado de nueves*" (*Oh kingdom of nines*), which expresses our longing convergence to *unity*. This piece, jubilant and Cuban, includes some explanations based on a geometric representation of the **Holy Spirit** found *here*. It invites us, of course, to the unsurpassable **love** of the **Just One** who **lives**.

Curiously, and surely not by chance, this composition in Spanish lasts 6:09, precisely matching the title of another significant and related numerical song on the blog that can be enjoyed <u>here</u>. Thank you, <u>Lázaro</u>, <u>Justo Emilio</u>, <u>Jean Carlos</u>, <u>Sergio</u>, <u>Joel</u>, and all the members of <u>Shanti Setú/Puente de Paz</u>! May the <u>Lord</u> give us what is required so that we may go forth and inspire!
